



TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT

WHO: Lee County Emergency Management will be sponsoring G-317 Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Train the Trainer Course June 22nd-24th 2011.

WHAT: This is a **2.5 day course** that will prepare emergency services instructors to deliver CERT training to citizens within their community. Topics include hazard awareness, disaster fire suppression, disaster medical operations, and light search & rescue team operations.

This course prepares participants to deliver FEMA's CERT Basic Training course.

This **TRAIN-THE-TRAINER** course focuses on preparing instructors to:

- Deliver CERT Basic Training
- Convey the messages and intent of the CERT Program (e.g., safety, teamwork, place in overall community Emergency Operations Plan)
- Assure that participants achieve the objectives of CERT Basic Training
- Create a comfortable yet managed learning environment

Course topics include:

- CERT history, program purpose, and values
- Materials and requirements for the CERT Basic Training course
- Roles of the CERT instructor
- Effective presentation of *CERT Basic Training* content
- Effective coaching and demonstration of skills in the classroom
- Practices to maximize learning
- Effective evaluation of CERT training participants

Selection Criteria: The target audience for this course includes those who will:

Serve as general CERT Basic Training course instructors

• Serve as specialized instructors delivering discipline specific training to CERT participants, (i.e. certified firefighters who will deliver Fire Safety training to basic CERT classes.)

Prerequisites Required:

Participants must be either:

Certified public safety professionals in one of the following disciplines: *Emergency Management, Emergency Medical Services, Fire and Rescue, or Law Enforcement.*

OR

Active **CERT** volunteers who have successfully completed a **CERT Basic Training** course, *including* participation in final drill. (Course Certificate required.)

AND

Have completed the following online courses by June 22nd 2011:

Independent Study IS 100b Introduction to Incident Command.
