PLEASE REGISTER

This year we are asking everyone in the Disabled Community to register with NPLB. This provides several benefits for our Disabled Community.

- Your registration allows NPLB to help the County, State, and Federal Agencies; to identify all those in need of possible help; and to account for those who are not registered with any other agency.
- It allows us to let Utility Companies (water and electric) to know how many persons with disabilities are without power or water in a given area or affected area.
- It will help NPLB to assist your evacuation from your residence or contact other Agencies to help in your transportation - before or after a disaster.

DISABLED COMMUNITY NEEDS TO BE PREPARED

The disabled community needs to be prepared for hurricanes and disasters in southwest Florida. In order to be prepared, each person should have an emergency hurricane and disaster plan.
